

FERRARI SUPER FAST

- SCHWARTZ STATED THAT HE WAS ORIGINALLY RECOMMENDED TO CLASSIC COACH BY HIS UNCLE WHO HAD PREVIOUSLY PURCHASED TWO CLASSIC FERRARIS FROM TRIARSI. SCHWARTZ ADDED THAT HIS UNCLE HAD NOTHING BUT A GOOD EXPERIENCE WHEN DEALING WITH TRIARSI AND THAT HE NEVER HAD ANY DISCREPANCIES OR ISSUES WITH THE QUALITY OF THE FERRARIS HE HAD PURCHASED FROM CLASSIC COACH.
- ACCORDING TO SCHWARTZ, HE BECAME ILL AND NEEDED TO SELL ALL HIS FERRARIS AND HAD SUBSEQUENTLY CAME IN CONTACT WITH A GENTLEMEN BY THE NAME OF ELLIOT GROSSMAN OF SYMBOLIC MOTORS LOCATED IN LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA. GROSSMAN WAS IN THE BUSINESS OF SELLING CLASSIC VEHICLES AT AUCTIONS AND HAD MANY CONTACTS. SCHWARTZ ADDED THAT GROSSMAN PROVIDED HIM \$75,000 AS COLLATERAL BEFORE HE WAS ABLE TO SELL THE 1972 FERRARI DAYTONA, FERRARI SUPER FAST AND THE 1958 SILVER FERRARI (VIN 0799). SCHWARTZ REMEMBERED RECEIVING A PHONE CALL FROM GROSSMAN STATING THAT HE HAD SOLD THE 1972 FERRARI DAYTONA, FERRARI SUPER FAST BUT HAD SOME PROBLEMS WITH THE TITLE AND OWNERSHIP OF THE 1958 SILVER FERRARI (VIN 0799).
- SCHWARTZ THEN REFUNDED \$40,000 TO GROSSMAN FOR THE RETURN OF THE SILVER SERIES 1 (VIN 0799). HE THEN CONTACTED TRIARSI REGARDING THE CONCERNS WITH THE TITLE AND/OR PROPER OWNERSHIP OF THE SILVER SERIES 1 (VIN 0799) WHICH TRIARSI ASSURED SCHWARTZ HAD NO PROBLEMS. TRIARSI ADVISED SCHWARTZ THAT HE WOULD PURCHASE THE SILVER SERIES 1 (0799) BACK FROM HIM WITHOUT ANY PROBLEMS.
- DURING THE INTERVIEW SCHWARTZ REMEMBERED THE NAME OF SCOTT ROSEN FROM THE ORIGINAL PURCHASE OF THE SERIES 1 (VIN 0799). SCHWARTZ BELIEVES THAT TRIARSI ACTED AS A BROKER IN THE SALE AND REPURCHASE OF THE SERIES 1 (VIN 0799).
- SCHWARTZ STATED THAT HE HAS NEVER MET SCOTT ROSEN AND HAS NOT RECEIVED ANY CALLS FROM TRIARSI SINCE HE SOLD THE SERIES 1 (VIN 0799) BACK TO HIM.
