

Action Taken: On September 4th, 2008 at 1100 hours, {all times approximate} this Detective of the Motor Vehicle Fraud Task Force and Detective Pinelli of the Statewide Auto Theft Task Force visited Mr. Shepak, the Litchfield County State's Attorney, and presented him with a Warrant Application requesting the authority to Search the garages located at the residence of Paul Hallingby DOB:11-11-46 located at 31 Kings Hill Road in Sharon, CT and Seize the 1958 Ferrari 250PF, with Vehicle Identification Number 0799GT, that was stolen in Spain in 1993.

State's Attorney Shepak reviewed the Warrant Application and found Probable Cause. He then instructed us to bring the Application to Judge Ginocchio of the Superior Court for further review.

Judge Ginocchio reviewed the Application and also found Probable Cause. He issued the Search and Seizure Warrant at 1205 hours.

This Detective and Detective Pinelli then met with Sergeants Kenney and Dency, and Detective Rodriguez, all members of the State Police Motor Vehicle Fraud Task Force, at the State Police Troop "L" Barracks in Litchfield. From there, we traveled to meet three uniformed Troopers, namely Trooper First Class Stonehill, Trooper Ring, and Trooper Combes, at a prearranged location in Sharon. All State Police personnel were advised of the Search Warrant to be executed at 31 Kings Hill Road. Detective Pinelli was assigned to photograph the scene and document the evidence seized.

The aforementioned State Police Personnel arrived at 31 Kings Hill Road at approximately 1330 hours. No one was present at the residence. This Detective immediately noticed a detached, single floor garage, red in color, with two garage bay doors that was not on the tax assessor's list for buildings at that address. This Detective peered into the garage from an unobstructed window and observed the target vehicle, a two door convertible, silver in color, with a red interior, on a vehicle lift to the rear of the garage on the left side. There were eight other vehicles in the garage.

Because there no longer existed a reason to search the garages listed on the Search Warrant, this Detective and Detective Pinelli left the premises in order to apply for a second Search and Seizure Warrant. Sergeant Kenney also left the premises and returned to Troop "L," leaving the remaining State Police Personnel at 31 Kings Hill Road. {Refer to Supplementary Report to be completed by Sergeant Dency regarding the events that transpired during our absence from the scene}

While at Troop "L," Detective Pinelli contacted Mr. Shepak and advised him of the new developments. Mr. Shepak stated that he did not need to review the new Search Warrant Application and that we could bring it

directly to Judge Ginocchio. Detective Pinelli then contacted the Judge's secretary and advised her of the new developments and the need to visit the Judge a second time.

This Detective completed the second Search and Seizure Warrant Application and, along with Detective Pinelli, met again with Judge Ginocchio. The Judge reviewed the Application and issued the second Search and Seizure Warrant at 1538 hours.

This Detective and Detective Pinelli, along with Sergeant Kenney, returned to 31 Kings Hill Road and arrived at 1605 hours. Mrs. Hallingby was now present and she was provided with a copy of the Search and Seizure Warrant. She faxed a copy to her attorney, James Pastore. Sergeant Kenney asked Mrs. Hallingby to open the garage in order for the silver 1958 Ferrari to be seized pursuant to the Court Order. Mrs. Hallingby replied that she does not have access to the garage because Mr. Hallingby forbids her from even touching his collector cars. The caretaker, a man who identified himself as "Bob Pinckney," stated that he had a key for the garage at his home, located a few minutes away. Mr. Pinckney stated that he will, on occasion, pull the vehicles out of the garage for Mr. Hallingby and park them in the driveway. Mr. Pinckney was permitted by Sergeant Kenney to leave the scene at 1630 hours in order to retrieve the key for the garage. Mr. Pinckney returned at 1700 hours. At 1705 hours, the garage was opened with the key.

There were nine vehicles in the garage, including the target vehicle. There was a yellow Ferrari parked in front of the target vehicle and a Mercedes parked under the target vehicle, which as previously mentioned, was on a lift. Mrs. Hallingby made contact with her husband over the phone on several occasions during the execution of the search warrant. He was vacationing in France. According to Mrs. Hallingby, Mr. Hallingby said he did not want the Police touching his cars. Mrs. Hallingby also requested that we wait for her attorney, Mr. Pastore, to arrive. Sergeant Kenney agreed to wait for the attorney. It should be noted that there was the strong odor of gasoline in the garage and once the doors were opened, we waited several minutes for the garage to ventilate before reentry. This Detective climbed onto the lift and opened the hood of the target vehicle, confirming the Vehicle Identification Number as "0799GT."

Mr. Pinckney stated that the target vehicle had recently been placed in the garage, having been transported from an unknown location.

Mr. Pastore arrived at approximately 1900 hours and was advised that the 1958 Ferrari would be seized and that several of the vehicles would have to be moved to facilitate the seizure. Mr. Pastore contacted Mr. Hallingby over the phone, who again reiterated his desire to have his cars untouched by the Police. Sergeant Kenney then advised Mr. Pastore that the cars could be moved by Mrs. Hallingby, Mr. Pinckney, or by Mr.

Pastore himself, otherwise the State Police would move them. Mr. Pastore refused to allow anyone to move the cars and stated that he did not see the reason that the target vehicle had to be removed from the garage, despite having a copy of the Search and Seizure Warrant in his hand.

At 1912 hours, this Detective, Sergeant Kenney, Detectives Pinelli and Rodriguez, and Sergeant Dency, along with Mr. Pinckney the caretaker, pushed the yellow Ferrari and silver Mercedes out of the garage. The target vehicle was then lowered and it too was pushed out of the garage. This Detective sat in each vehicle, steering them as they were pushed. Once the target vehicle was removed from the garage, the yellow Ferrari and the silver Mercedes were pushed back into the garage. The weather forecast had called for high winds and heavy rains.

At 1948 hours, "Sharon Auto Body," a company experienced in the towing of specialty vehicles, arrived at the residence to tow the target vehicle. Eric Golden and Bob Carberry were the wrecker operators. The target vehicle was loaded onto the flatbed and taken from the scene at 2030 hours. Just prior to departure, Mr. Pastore asked this Detective to contact him when the Warrant for Mr. Hallingby's Arrest was obtained.

At 2140 hours, the 1958 Ferrari arrived at the secure, climate controlled, State Police garage. The vehicle was secured in the garage at 2150 hours.

On September 5th, 2008, this Detective contacted Interpol and advised them of the seizure. Ms. Worthington, the Interpol operator who assisted this Detective in the past during this investigation, advised that the Teletype referencing the stolen Ferrari had been purged from the system on September 1st, 2008 per their procedure. However, she requested that a Locate Teletype be sent in order for their case to be closed. This Detective sent that Teletype.

This Detective then contacted Oliver Weber, the victim's attorney, via e-mail and advised him of the previous night's seizure.

- 1. The Affiants, Detective Richard Van Tine II #732 and Detective Peter Pinelli #468, are sworn members of the Connecticut State Police and have been so employed for the past thirteen and ten years, respectively. The Affiants have participated in numerous investigations resulting in the issuance of Search and Seizure Warrants and Arrest Warrants for crimes violating Connecticut General Statutes. The Affiants have attended various schools and training seminars related to criminal investigation. At all times mentioned herein, the Affiants were acting in their official capacities as sworn members of the aforementioned agency. The following facts and circumstances are related from the personal knowledge, investigation, and observation of the Affiants and include information related to the Affiants by fellow officers and persons with knowledge of the facts and/or circumstances contained herein.
- 2. On May 29th, 2008, Affiant Van Tine was contacted by Inspector Zak of the State's Attorney's Office in Bridgeport regarding a report of a stolen vehicle. Inspector Zak provided Affiant Van Tine with the phone number of a person who had information on a stolen vehicle that might be located in Connecticut. This person wishes to remain anonymous. He/She will be referred to herein as the "Confidential Source."
- 3. The Confidential Source in this investigation is a retired Detective Sergeant from a municipality with a regularly organized Police Department within the State of New York. The Confidential Source has over twenty years of investigative experience. The information that he/she provided in this investigation has been corroborated and proven to be true, accurate, and reliable.
- he/she stated to In conversations with the Confidential Source, Affiant Van Tine that he/she was aware of a 1958 Ferrari 250PF, with Vehicle Identification Number 0799GT that was stolen in Spain in the early 1990's that he/she believes is now being stored in Connecticut. The Confidential Source stated that the vehicle is very rare and worth several million dollars. The Confidential Source stated that a Paul "Barney" Hallingby of Sharon, CT, is currently holding the vehicle. The Confidential Source provided Affiant Van Tine with a history of the vehicle that he/she obtained from the Internet. The history shows that the vehicle was reported as "disappeared, stolen" prior to 1993 and, after having changed hands several times, is currently owned by "Paul Hallingby, CT, US." The Confidential Source showed Affiant Van Tine an advertisement in "Cavallino," a magazine that caters to high-end vehicle collectors, stating that the 1958 Ferrari 0799GT, is Identification Number advertisement states that the vehicle is listed in the Interpol system as with Vehicle stolen. The Confidential Source also provided Affiant Van Tine with a "Guide

to all Ferraris" that shows their value. The 1958 Ferrari 250PF, with Vehicle Identification Number 0799GT, is worth between 3 million and 4.5 million dollars.

- 5. Affiant Van Tine then performed a check of DMV Records and found that the 1958 Ferrari 250PF, with Vehicle Identification Number 0799GT, is in fact registered to Paul Hallingby DOB: 11-11-46 as of August 4th, 2008. The registration will expire on March 31st, 2009. A DMV check of Mr. Hallingby's license revealed an address of Kings Hill Road in Sharon, CT. A check of all vehicles currently registered or registered in the past to Mr. Hallingby shows that all but one were registered to either PO Box 544 or to Kings Hill Road, both in Sharon, CT. One vehicle, with the registration having expired in 1995, was registered to him at 501 Lake Avenue in Greenwich, CT. One vehicle in particular, however, is currently registered to him at 31 Kings Hill Road in Sharon, CT. Mr. Hallingby owns twenty-two vehicles, eighteen of which are collector vehicles. Of those, five are Ferrari's. He has owned two other Ferrari's in the past.
- 6. Affiant Van Tine confirmed through Interpol that the 1958 Ferrari 250PF, with Vehicle Identification Number 0799GT was stolen in Marbella, Spain between the dates of May $1^{\rm st}$, 1993 and September $30^{\rm th}$, 1993 and was reported as such to Interpol by the Swiss Police. It remains listed in Interpol as "stolen."
- 7. Affiant Van Tine spoke with Inspector Gilroy of the Connecticut DMV regarding any title information on the 1958 Ferrari 250PF, with Vehicle Identification Number 0799GT. According to Inspector Gilroy, there is no title for a vehicle of that age.
- 8. Affiant Van Tine then visited several Ferrari related Internet websites. One was the "Greenwich Concours d'Elegance" website. The "Greenwich Concours d'Elegance" is a car show where collector vehicles are shown and judged. During the 2005 "Greenwich Concours d'Elegance," Hallingby showed the 1958 Ferrari 250PF, with Vehicle Identification Number 0799GT. It is listed on the website for that year. Affiant Van Tine could locate no listing of vehicles shown in more recent "Greenwich Concours d'Elegance" shows. Affiant Van Tine also visited several websites where those people who are knowledgeable about Ferraris can correspond. According to postings on those websites, it is common knowledge in the "Ferrari World" that the 1958 Ferrari 250PF, with Vehicle Identification Number 0799GT, has a questionable background though not all postings indicate that Ferrari aficionados believe it was stolen. It is also known that Mr. Hallingby is in possession of that vehicle.

- 9. Affiant Van Tine then contacted Oliver Weber, the Swiss attorney who represents Dr. Andreas Gerber, the owner of the 1958 Ferrari 250PF with Vehicle Identification Number 0799GT when it was stolen. Mr. Weber agreed to provide Affiant Van Tine with all documentation he has on the vehicle.
- Affiant Van Tine then received from Inspector Gilroy of the DMV, 10. certificate and registration the Connecticut Identification Number Verification Certificate regarding the vehicle. These documents show that the vehicle is registered to Paul Hallingby DOB: 11-11-46. Mr. Hallingby listed his Mailing Address as PO Box 544 in Sharon, CT but listed his Residence Address as 31 Kings Hill Road in Sharon, CT. A DMV Inspector confirmed the known VIN of "0799GT". The documents also show that Hallingby purchased the vehicle for \$550,000.00 on November 29th, 2000 from Scott Rosen of 111 Hempstead Turnpike in West Hempstead, NY. It should be noted that the registration certificate shows that the VIN of the vehicle was first printed as "FER079958." This was then crossed out and the number "0799" was written beside it. The VIN Verification Certificate shows the correct VIN of 0799GT.
- 11. Affiant Van Tine also received from Inspector Gilroy of the DMV, copies of a New Jersey Title listing the owner of the vehicle as Jeffrey Schwartz of 110 Tekening Drive in Tenafly, NJ, an "Odometer Disclosure and Statement of Seller" listing the "buyer" as Scott Rosen and the "seller" as Jeffrey Schwartz, and a "Certification of Sale or Transfer for 1972 or Older Vehicles or any other Non-Title Vehicles" listing the "seller" as Scott Rosen and the "purchaser" as Paul Hallingby."
- 12. On July 21st, 2008, Affiant Van Tine received numerous documents from Oliver Weber, the Swiss attorney who represents the victim in this case. The documents highlight the investigation conducted by him on behalf of his client. There are three "Requests for Seizure and Recovery." Each has an original signature of Mr. Weber. These "Requests" provide a detailed summary of the events surrounding the theft of the vehicle, the actions of individuals who have possessed the vehicle since its theft, and information on the current possessor who is believed to be Paul "Barney" Hallingby DOB: 11-11-46 of 31 Kings Hill Road in Sharon, CT. Mr. Weber also provided three "Directories of Evidence Documents," two of which have attachments. The primary "Directory" has original notarized statements and signatures and the other having attachments contains copies of those notarized statements and signatures. The attachments are various articles, statements, and other documents that support the accusations made in the aforementioned "Requests for Seizure and Recovery."

- 13. A check of the Tax Assessor's website for Sharon, CT was performed by Detective Verno, also of the State Police Motor Vehicle Fraud Task Force. He found that the address of 31 Kings Hill Road in Sharon, CT is associated with Mr. Hallingby, though he is not listed as the taxpayer of the property. He then performed an Internet search of Paul "Barney" Hallingby and located two telephone numbers for Mr. Hallingby that return to 31 Kings Hill Road in Sharon, CT. Also obtained from the Tax Assessor's website are the "footprints" of the two garages at 31 Kings Hill Road in Sharon, CT. The first, a garage attached to the residence, measures approximately 25 feet wide by 26 feet long. The second, a detached garage, measures approximately 41 feet wide by 44 feet long and is two floors tall.
- 14. According to the "Condon & Skelly" Insurance Company, the company that insures the 1958 Ferrari 250PF with Vehicle Identification Number 0799GT, Mr. Hallingby failed to notify them of the location where the Ferrari is stored when he obtained the policy. "Condon & Skelly" contacted Mr. Hallingby and requested that information. On August 19th, 2008, Mr. Hallingby responded via e-mail and stated that all of his collector vehicles are "kept in purpose built garages in Sharon, CT where we have a home." He further stated that "we have a caretaker that visits all the facilities daily." Mr. Hallingby also inquired as to why "Condon & Skelly" was specifically asking about the 1958 Ferrari 250PF with Vehicle Identification Number 0799GT.
- 15. The Affiants know through training and experience that individuals who possess high priced collector vehicles will store those vehicles in secure garages hidden from public view but convenient for their own access. Hallingby currently owns twenty-two vehicles, eighteen of which are collector vehicles. Of those, five are Ferrari's. He has owned two other Ferrari's in the past. 





The Affiants, Detective Richard Van Tine II #732 and Detective Peter Pinelli #468, are sworn members of the Connecticut State Police and have been so employed for the past thirteen and ten years, numerous respectively. 250PF, with Vehicle Identification Number 0799GT, has a questionable background though not all postings indicate that Ferrari aficionados believe it was stolen. It is also known that Mr. Hallingby is in possession of that vehicle.

ACTION TAKEN: On Thursday 09/11/2008 at approx 1:30 PM, I contacted the Town of Sharon, Connecticut Tax Assessor Deborah REYELT on the telephone at 860-364-0205. The reason for the contact was to check the Tax records at the Assessors Office regarding what buildings on the property were located at #31 Kings Hill Road, as it was suspected that the large garage/barn that was used for vehicle storage was not included on the Tax Records for the property.

I identified myself and inquired on the Sharon Tax records for the property located at #31 Kings Hill Road in Sharon. The Tax Assessor reported that the property is owned by a Julia M. HARTLEY of Seven Gracie Square #10B, New York, New York 10028. (Wife of Paul HALLINGBY) The Assessor reported that there are only 2 buildings on the tax records, and it appears that the Garage/Barn is not listed as being on the property. The Tax Assessor agreed to FAX a copy of the Sharon Tax Records for the property. The Assessor was asked specifically if there was another building on the records and she reported that there was not. I inquired when the last Tax Assessment was done, and she reported that it was 5 years ago, and that the town was conducting an assessment currently, but that the property located at #31 Kings Hill Road had not been reviewed yet. I advised the Assessor that there was a large Garage/Barn on the left side of the driveway. She was obviously surprised and upset that the structure was not included in the tax Records and insured me that the matter would be addressed. The Assessor asked how long the structure had been there. I advised her that I was told by Julia last week that the Garage/Barn had been built 8 to 9 years ago.

The FAX of the Property Records for #31 Kings Hill Road in Sharon was received at approx. 1415 hours and is attached.



Action Taken: On 08/04/2008 at approximately 1330 hrs, this Sergeant assisted with the execution of a Search and Seizure warrant at 31 Kings Hill rd Sharon, CT the residence of Paul L. Hallingby. This stemmed from an investigation by Detective Van Tine regarding a stolen 1958 Ferrari 250 PF.

Upon arriving at the residence and knocking on the front door of the main residence, the homeowners did not answer. There were two (2) Labrador type dogs located inside the front foyer of the residence.

At approximately 1335 hrs, the caretaker of the residence Sharon Hughes (10 Cemetery rd Sharon, CT) (Phone #860-824-0451), arrived on the property and stated that the property owners were away in France.

Hughes provided a phone number of 011.33.5.53.59.49.90 for Paul Hallingby whom the referred to as "Barney". When I asked Hughes if she was taking care of the two dogs she replied "What dogs, there are no dogs inside". I informed her that there were indeed two dogs in the house and Hughes then stated, "If the dogs are inside then they must be home". Hughes unlocked the residence and walked inside with this Sergeant and TFC Robert Stonehill. A brief cursory search was conducted of the residence and the homeowners were not located inside.

At approximately 1520 hrs, Mrs. Hallingby arrived on the property and was advised of the Search Warrant. She stated that her husband whom she referred to as "Barney" was away in France. Mrs. Hallingby stated that her husband was the only one who had a key to unlock the door to the exterior garage. Mrs. Hallingby contacted Paul Hallingby via telephone who requested to speak with this Sergeant. I advised Paul of the Search and Seizure Warrant for the older model 1950's vintage Ferrari. Paul, without hesitation, stated that he was aware of the car and that it was locked in the exterior garage on a car lift behind four other vehicles. Paul stated that he was the only one with keys to the garage and that he would be glad to assist me upon his return from France on 09/21/2008. Paul stated he is the only one authorized to legally drive the vehicles. I asked Paul if there is anyone he knew that could move the vehicles in the garage to gain access to the Ferrari and he stated "NO".

This Sergeant was contacted by Attorney Pastore (203-661-4200) of the Russell Pastore law firm who advised that he was the legal counsel for the Hallingby's. Pastore was explained the nature of the investigation. Pastore requested a copy of the Search Warrant be faxed to him. A copy was provided to Mrs. Hallingby who then faxed it to Pastore from her home fax machine. Upon further conversation with Attorney Pastore and Paul Hallingby, Hallingby stated that one of the property caretakers, "Bob Pinckney", who was on the scene, had a key to the garage at his residence. Hallingby requested that Pinckney allow Police access to the "garage only" and not to move any of the vehicles. Attorney Pastore stated that he would be enroute to the scene.

Pinckney departed the residence and arrived back approximately thirty minutes later with the key which he gave to Mrs. Hallingby. Mrs. Hallingby next opened the side door of the garage where search team members immediately detected the strong odor of gasoline vapors. Due to the immediate hazard the garage was ventilated for several minutes prior to entry.

This Sergeant observed the 1958 Ferrari located on the second tier of a two level car lift, on the left side of the garage as you face inward. There was one vehicle directly beneath the Ferrari (silver Mercedes) and another Ferrari in front of that. I observed the keys to be in all of the vehicles in the garage. I observed the 1958 Ferrari to be dirty with bug splatter on the front windshield and nose of the vehicle. There were numerous paint bubbles observed on the nose of the vehicle also. These defects were photographed by Det Pinell. (Refer to photo supplement)

Upon consulting with Attorney Pastore who was on scene I advised him that we would be taking possession of the vehicle and inquired if Mr. Hallingby wished to have someone move said vehicles or search team members could fulfill this task. Pastore was also given the option of choosing who would transport the seized vehicle to an undisclosed location.

After not receiving a definitive answer the decision was made to have Search team members move all vehicles by hand to gain access and seize the Ferrari. The Ferrari was towed from the scene via Sharon Automotive flatbed tow service to an undisclosed secure location.
