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
Action Taken: On August 19th, 2009, this Detective completed the arrest warrant application for Paul "Barney" Hallingby DOB: 11-11-46 charging him with one count of Larceny I {C.G.S. §53a-122}.

This Detective and Sergeant Kenney later met with Mr. Shepack at his office to discuss the case. Mr. Shepack stated that he believed Probable Cause existed for arrest but was not convinced that there was sufficient admissible evidence to prove Hallingby's guilt beyond a reasonable doubt at trial. He added that a trial in this case would involve great expense of time and resources because witnesses would have to be located and brought to Court from places as far away as Europe. A lengthy discussion of the case was conducted. At the conclusion of the meeting, Mr. Shepack stated that once he made a final decision, he would notify this Detective.

In a letter dated September 14th, 2009, Mr. Shepack responded by letter that he was declining prosecution of Hallingby because he concluded that "the available and admissible evidence is not sufficient to allow the State to meet its burden of proof at trial." He noted on the Warrant Application, "Prosecution Declined."

Attached to this report are the aforementioned letter and Arrest Warrant Application.

This Case Closed Suspended. Should any new information be developed, the investigation will be re-opened.
